

**Data privacy notice
concerning the processing of personal data
as part of the Norwegian Financial Mechanism and the EEA Financial
Mechanism for the years 2014–2021**

Pursuant to Articles 13(1) and 13(2) of the GDPR,¹ please be advised that:

- 1) The controller of your personal data is the Polish Minister of Health whose office is located in Warsaw (00-952) at ul. Miodowa 15. The controller may be contacted in writing or by e-mail at kancelaria@mz.gov.pl.
- 2) The controller has appointed a data protection officer who may be contacted by sending an e-mail to iod@mz.gov.pl or by writing to the controller's address. The data protection officer may be contacted with respect to any and all matters concerning personal data processing or if you would like to exercise your rights related to data processing.
- 3) Your personal data is processed in order to carry out the projects implemented as part of the Norwegian Financial Mechanism and the EEA Financial Mechanism for the years 2014–2021, to monitor the process of maintaining the sustainability of projects, and to store the documents concerning these projects.
- 4) Personal data processing takes place in connection with:
 - a) the performance by the controller of tasks carried out in the public interest or the exercise of official authority vested in the controller—Article 6(1)(e) of the GDPR, which is related to:
 - the Memorandum of Understanding on the implementation of the EEA Financial Mechanism 2014–2021 between Iceland, the Principality of Liechtenstein, the Kingdom of Norway and the Republic of Poland;
 - the Memorandum of Understanding on the implementation of the Norwegian Financial Mechanism 2014–2021 between the Kingdom of Norway and the Republic of Poland;
 - the Regulation on the implementation of the Norwegian Financial Mechanism 2014–2021 adopted by the Norwegian Ministry of Foreign Affairs on 23 September 2016 pursuant to Article 10.5 of the Agreement between the Kingdom of Norway and the European Union on a Norwegian Financial Mechanism for the period 2014–2021, as amended;
 - the Regulation on the implementation of the European Economic Area Financial Mechanism 2014–2021 adopted by the EEA Financial Mechanism Committee on 8 September 2016 pursuant to Article 10.5 of Protocol 38c to the EEA Agreement and confirmed by the Standing Committee of the EFTA States on 23 September 2016, as amended;
 - the Program Agreement of 12 September 2019 executed between the Polish Minister of Investment and Development and the Norwegian Minister of Foreign Affairs for the financing of the “Health” Program;

- the Agreement on the Bilateral Cooperation Fund of 4 September 2018 executed between the Polish Minister of Investments and Development, the Financial Mechanism Committee, and the Norwegian Ministry of Foreign Affairs;
 - the Memorandum of Understanding on the implementation of the “Health” Program under the Norwegian Financial Mechanism 2014–2021 executed between the Polish Minister of Finance, Investments, and Development and the Polish Minister of Health on 18 November 2019;
- b) the performance of a contract to which the data subject is party where the processing of personal data is necessary to execute and perform that contract—Article 6(1)(b) of the GDPR.
- 5) Your personal data may be shared with other recipients or categories of recipients of personal data. In justified cases and on the basis of the relevant legal regulations, the recipients of your personal data may be entities authorized to receive them, including third countries that are not EU Member States.
 - 6) Your personal data will be stored for the period necessary to monitor the process of maintaining the sustainability of the projects and to store the documents related to the projects implemented as part of the Norwegian Financial Mechanism and the EEA Financial Mechanism for the years 2014–2021.
 - 7) You have the right to access your data and receive a copy of it, the right to rectify it, and the right to restriction of data processing.
 - 8) Your provision of your data is a prerequisite for maintaining the sustainability of the project as part of the EEA Financial Mechanism 2014–2021 and the Norwegian Financial Mechanism 2014–2021.
 - 9) We do not process your personal data in an automated manner, including in the form of profiling.
 - 10) You have the right to file a complaint with the supervisory authority, i.e. the President of the Polish Personal Data Protection Office (address: ul. Stawki 2, 00-193 Warsaw). You may do this if you believe that we are processing your personal data in violation of the applicable legal regulations.
